- Lack of computer literacy is an identified barrier to employment
- Must be referred by a WorkBC Employment Service Centre Case Manager
- Has established a regular Employment Insurance (EI) claim in the last three years, or a parental claim in the past five years
- Not attending school and not participating in another Labour Market Agreement funded program.
